**Infant Baptism** may take place during any weekend Mass or at 1:15 p.m. on any Sunday. Baptism classes are held monthly.

Adult Entrance into the Catholic Church takes place through the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.)**.

For adolescents, preparation for **Confirmation** takes place within the Religious Education Program. For adults, preparation takes place through a brief special program.

**Matrimony** Diocesan directives require at least 6 months notice. An interview with the pastor is required before a date can be placed on the parish schedule. A marriage preparation course is provided periodically by the parish.

**Reconciliation** (Confession) is scheduled on Saturdays from 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. or by appointment with one of the priests.

**Anointing of the Sick** is available to anyone seriously ill or anticipating surgery.

**Interpreted Mass for the Deaf** every Sunday at the 9:00 a.m. Mass.

**THE WORD OF GOD THIS SUNDAY:** For this Sunday, the Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Scriptural readings begin with a passage from the Second Book of Samuel where the prophet Nathan speaks bluntly to David about his unfaithfulness. In the second reading, from St. Paul's Letter to the Galatians we hear the author speak of the source of salvation. In the Gospel passage, Jesus deals with sin and forgiveness. The Scriptural readings for this Sunday speak of sin and salvation and ask us to reflect on these realities in our lives.

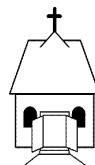

### MUSIC CORNER By David Dreher

Psalm 32 God, *I Confess My Wrong*, is one of the Entreaty Psalms (also known as Repentance Psalms of which there are 7 other Repentance Psalms. The others are 6,38 51,102, 130 and 143.). These psalms are arranged as either community or individual psalms. Some commentaries attribute this psalm to King David after he took Uriah’s wife to be his own and had Uriah killed in battle. It was only after David confessed his sinfulness to God that he experienced God’s loving mercy. Our readings and music today reflect the need to confess our sins and to experience the bountiful mercy of God. David Haas’ haunting melody for our psalm reflects the wandering of our emotions under sin. Verse 1 tells of how painful his body felt under the weight of unacknowledged sin. Verse 3 rejoices in the freedom felt when the psalmist repents and experiences the joy of living “in the shelter of God.”

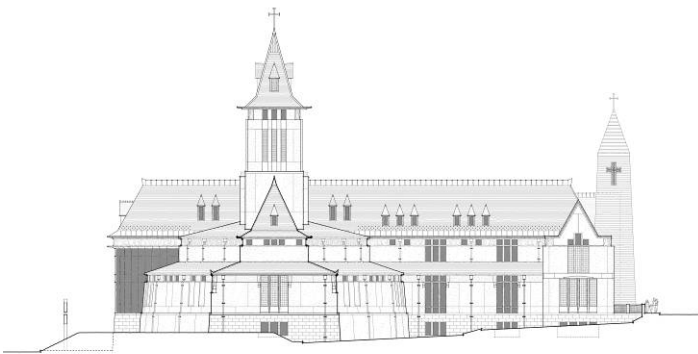
