Infant Baptism may take place during any weekend Mass or at 1:15 p.m. on any Sunday. Baptism classes are held monthly.

Adult Entrance into the Catholic Church takes place through the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.)**.

For adolescents, preparation for **Confirmation** takes place within the Religious Education Program. For adults, preparation takes place through a brief special program.

Matrimony Diocesan directives require at least 6 months notice. An interview with the pastor is required before a date can be placed on the parish schedule. A marriage preparation course is provided periodically by the parish.

Reconciliation (Confession) is scheduled on Saturdays from 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. or by appointment with one of the priests.

Anointing of the Sick is available to anyone seriously ill or anticipating surgery.

Interpreted Mass for the Deaf every Sunday at the 9:00 a.m. Mass.

THE WORD OF GOD THIS SUNDAY: For this Sunday, the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Scriptural readings begin with a passage from the Book of the Prophet Zephaniah in which we are told of what the Lord is prepared to do to purify His people. In the second reading, from St. Paul's Letter to the Galatians we hear the unity that comes to those baptized into Christ. In the Gospel passage, Jesus clearly shares with the apostles of what lies ahead for Him. The Scriptural readings for this Sunday tell us that while the Lord will indeed do wonders in our lives, there will be crosses as well.

PASTOR'S THOUGHTS: Each week, please look in this space for some random thoughts from the pastor. The summer months are devoted not only to programs for young people (Bible Camp and Summer Religious Education) but also major cleaning and preparing rooms for the fall. Please be careful as you pass through work areas as you proceed to and from weekend Masses.

CLEARANCES - ALL MINISTERS AND VOLUNTEERS: All Ministers and Volunteers Bishop Zubik and the policies of the Diocese of Pittsburgh demand that all those in any parish ministry on any consultative body or volunteer where children and young people are involved must have appropriate clearances. Periodic audits are made of parish child protection records. It is expected that all clearances are on file and up to date. Appropriate forms to complete the process may be obtained at the Parish Center on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday from 4:30 to 9:00 pm. PARISH SCHOOL PRINCIPAL TRANSITION: Sister Kathy Kudlac, OSF will not be returning to Saint Kilian Parish School next year. We take this opportunity to thank her on behalf of the entire parish for all that she did to establish our parish school in its new location. She has been unselfish in her efforts and we are all grateful and promise her our prayers and best wishes as she devotes her talent and ability to a new ministry. We also welcome Mrs. Rosanne Qwiatkowski as principal of our parish school. She arrives with enormous experience in Catholic education and great enthusiasm for her new position. She and Sister Kathy will be working on many details of transition in these final weeks of June. Mrs. Kwiatkowski officially begins her work on July 1st, but she is present in the Parish Center most days.

PATRIOTIC CONCERT: A concert entitled HOMELAND will be given on Friday, June 25th at 7:00 p.m. at Saint Kilian Parish, and also on Sunday, June 27th at 3:00 p.m. at Mars Alliance Church on Route 228. Members of Saint Kilian Adult Choir will join their voices in a community chorale of over 50 voices from 19 churches and organizations in the area. DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO THE NATIONAL SHRINE (WASHINGTON, DC): Bishop Zubik will be leading a pilgrimage to the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington D.C. on Saturday, October 9, 2010. It will be an opportunity to join Catholics from all over the Diocese to pray for our own intentions and God's blessing on our Diocese and its' leaders. Each parish has been asked to consider sponsoring a bus for this pilgrimage. Saint Kilian Parish is considering doing so. The cost will be approximately \$55-\$60 per person. This amount includes the cost of the bus, a boxed meal and drink for each person during the trip home. This can be a great family event and a way to meet other parishioners. 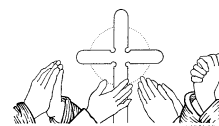

MUSIC CORNER By David Dreher

Psalm 63 *My Soul Is Thirsting*, reminds us that prayer, - thirsting for God – is the fountainhead of redemption. On the one hand, prayer is a gift from God (1st reading). On the other, it is a choice on our part (Gospel). Always it is a relationship that reveals both who God is and who we are. Prayer teaches us that we are souls in need of divine nourishment (psalm), sinners in need of repentance and purification (1st reading), and disciples called to acknowledge Christ and carry the cross (Gospel). Prayer also teaches u that God is our greatest good and ultimate satisfaction, that God acts to bring us to repentance, and that God in Christ takes up the cross ahead of us. 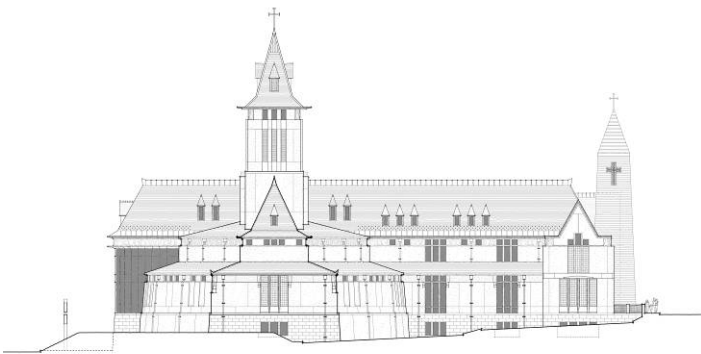
