**Infant Baptism** may take place during any weekend Mass or at 1:15 p.m. on any Sunday. Baptism classes are held monthly.

Adult Entrance into the Catholic Church takes place through the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.)**.

For adolescents, preparation for **Confirmation** takes place within the Religious Education Program. For adults, preparation takes place through a brief special program.

**Matrimony** Diocesan directives require at least 6 months notice. An interview with the pastor is required before a date can be placed on the parish schedule. A marriage preparation course is provided periodically by the parish.

**Reconciliation** (Confession) is scheduled on Saturdays from 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. or by appointment with one of the priests.

**Anointing of the Sick** is available to anyone seriously ill or anticipating surgery.

**Interpreted Mass for the Deaf** every Sunday at the 9:00 a.m. Mass.

**THE WORD OF GOD THIS SUNDAY:** For this Sunday, the Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Scriptural readings begin with a passage from the First Book of Kings where we are told of the handing on of the prophetic ministry from Elijah to Elisha. In the second reading, from St. Paul's Letter to the Galatians we are reminded that our baptism provides freedom, but that the freedom must be used wisely. In the Gospel passage, Jesus moves toward Jerusalem and destiny and invites the disciples to commit to remain with Him. The Scriptural readings for this Sunday challenge us about the depth of our commitments.

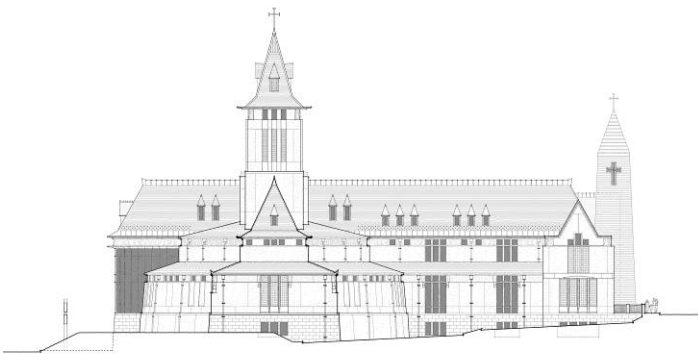

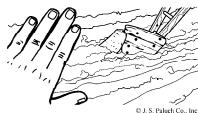
