Infant Baptism may take place during any weekend Mass or at 1:15 p.m. on any Sunday. Baptism classes are held monthly.

Adult Entrance into the Catholic Church takes place through the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.)**.

For adolescents, preparation for **Confirmation** takes place within the Religious Education Program. For adults, preparation takes place through a brief special program.

Matrimony Diocesan directives require at least 6 months notice. An interview with the pastor is required before a date can be placed on the parish schedule. A marriage preparation course is provided periodically by the parish.

Reconciliation (Confession) is scheduled on Saturdays from 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. or by appointment with one of the priests.

Anointing of the Sick is available to anyone seriously ill or anticipating surgery.

Interpreted Mass for the Deaf every Sunday at the 9:00 a.m. Mass.

THE WORD OF GOD THIS SUNDAY: The Scripture readings for this Sunday, the Seventeenth in Ordinary Time, continues with a passage from the Book of Genesis in which Abraham utilizes his favor with God to plead for mercy. In the second reading, from St. Paul's Letter to the Colossians, we are reminded that the death and resurrection of Christ brings us salvation and life. In the Gospel passage, Jesus teaches His disciples of the mercy of God. The Scriptural readings for this Sunday help us to understand our standing with God because of Christ and our obligations because of it.

As we move into the final weeks of summer, it is clear that the usual September events cannot be far off. Please note that preparations are underway for Religious Education classes. Parents are reminded that spaces are filling up so if you have not yet registered, please do so as soon as possible.

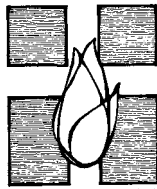

MUSIC CORNER By David Dreher

Our psalm today, Psalm 138 *On The Day I Called*, is a statement of absolute confidence in a God who listens to prayer. This confidence stands on past fulfillment (as in the 1st reading) and on future assurance (as in the Gospel). And it stands on the very nature of God whose “kindness and truth” will complete what has been begun in us (psalm). These readings and psalm teach us not only about prayer, but also about God’s response. We sometimes forget how much our own presence and prayer affects those around us at liturgy, and even the entire assembly. If I am deeply immersed in prayer, that draws those around me into deeper prayer. If I sing whole heartedly, that adds to the swell of the sung prayer of the whole assembly. If I respond well, that adds to the full voice of the prayer. Liturgy is celebrated by a community and each member affects the prayer of each other. Let us sing, and pray with confidence.

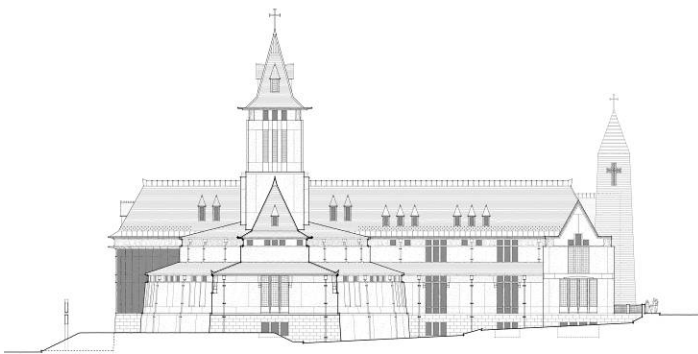
